

NEW PHONO MODULE

Specialist of high end audio electronics, the French manufacturer B.AUDIO introduces its new phono stage as an optional module. It offers the possibility to connect a turntable directly to B.AUDIO's Alpha One integrated amplifier or any dac-preamp from B.AUDIO without compromise on sound quality.

Benefiting from the team's experience in analog signal processing and from the lessons learned during the development of B.AUDIO's reference electronics, each internal step has been carefully engineered to deliver the highest performance, such as the low-noise input stage featuring matched transistors mounted in parallel and the passive RIAA correction made of 2 distinctive stages. Signal processing is performed exclusively in the analog domain.

Both moving-magnet (MM) and moving-coil (MC) cartridges are supported and multiple settings are parametrable to match any cartridge model, including impedance and gain which can be adjusted live using the remote control.



A full analog system featuring an Alpha One with phono stage was presented at the last High End Munich exhibition.

COMPATIBILITY & AVAILABILITY

This new optional phono board can be installed in the following B.AUDIO units: B.dpr one / B.dpr one EX / B.dpr / B.dpr EX and Alpha One.

It is priced at EUR 2,000 incl. VAT when fitted as standard. The cost of the upgrade including the necessary modifications is EUR 2,500 incl. VAT for existing models. It is available starting from now.
