Audirvāna's 3.0 update for its flagship product, Audirvāna Studio, is now available, delivering a complete redesign of the software and its mobile app, along with enhanced signal processing capabilities.

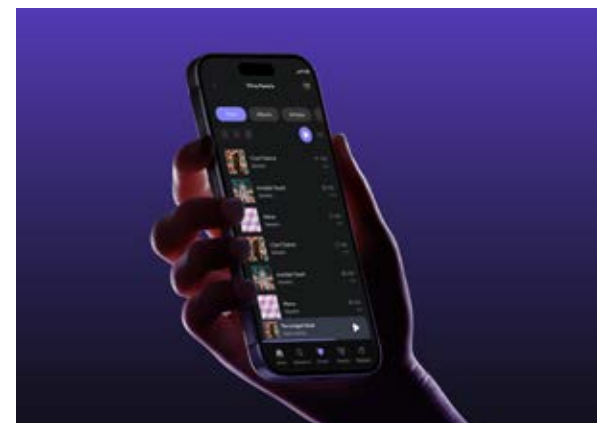
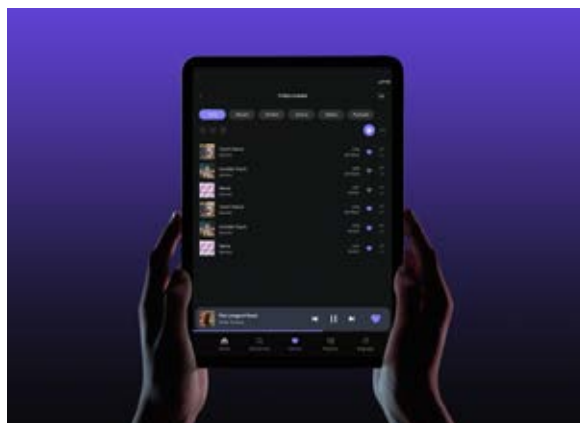
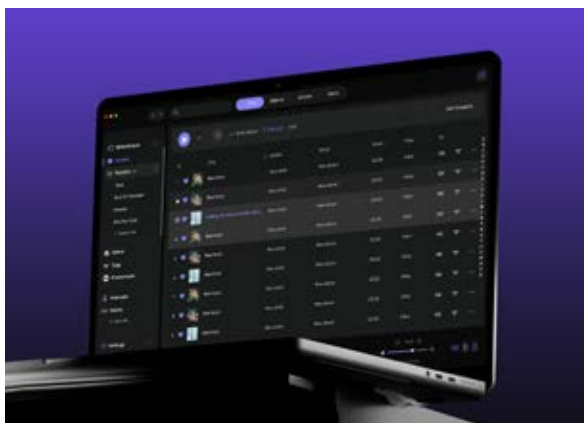
After over a year of development and a successful beta testing phase, update 3.0 is now available to all Audirvāna Studio users. It applies to all Mac, Windows, and Linux versions of the software, as well as the Audirvāna Remote mobile app for tablets and smartphones.

Subscribers simply need to accept the update offered when launching their software and update the corresponding mobile app from the Play Store for the Android version or the App Store for the iOS version. These updates are offered at no additional cost as part of their Audirvāna Studio subscription.

The 'Allegro' design introduces a completely new user experience that is more intuitive and easier to read.

It offers a simpler, more elegant interface, where everything is clearer and easier to find than before. Of course, the overall architecture remains the same, and the advanced options are still available and have even been enhanced, but without compromising clarity:

- Harmonized design across mobile, tablet, and computer versions
- Navigation filters placed at the top, as in streaming apps
- Contextual controls only appear if they can be used on a view
- Fonts and controls enlarged, highlighted, or illustrated with visual pictograms
- Redundant navigation to avoid blockages or complex handling
- New advanced settings panel with directly accessible technical explanations



'We couldn't wait to try it out ourselves! This time, the design started with the mobile app, with the ambition of matching the best streaming players on the market. Of course, they don't have to manage a local library or our advanced features, but they are the gold standard in terms of usability, including for our users. So we compared and questioned our choices on all aspects, then applied the resulting new design principles to the software, such as filters and contextual controls, for example, to make the Audirvāna experience consistent regardless of the device used.' explains Damien Plisson, Founder & CEO.

The new signal processing suite includes EQ, a convolution engine, a crossfeed function for headphone listening, and a balance control.

The 10-band parametric equalizer added to Audirvāna Studio last year can now be fully controlled from the mobile app, allowing you to make adjustments from the comfort of your favorite listening position: a first! The equalizer incorporates a complete signal processing suite that also includes:

- **A multichannel convolution engine**, mainly used to optimize the behavior of a system in a specific environment (e.g., room acoustic correction) by combining the audio signal (music) with a precalculated filter also known as an “impulse response file.” Channel/track mapping files are supported in multichannel and can be mixed to achieve crossovers, for example.
- **A crossfeed for headphone listening** that subtly mixes the left and right channels of a stereo recording to achieve a more natural feeling, as if listening on speakers.
- **A multichannel balance with gain and delay** that allows for even sound distribution, especially to compensate for asymmetrical speaker positions in the room.



‘This is an important step for Audirvāna in providing professionals and discerning audiophiles with the technical tools they may need. Feedback from the beta test has been unanimous in its praise of the quality, which is absolutely key to us. This work is the result of new developments within our company and new fruitful collaborations which opens up further prospects for us to remain a technological benchmark in our field.’ says Damien Plisson.

Price

Audirvāna Studio is available as a subscription service for €7.99 per month with no commitment, or €79.99 per year (respectively US \$7.99 and US \$79.99 before sales tax or the equivalent in other currencies).

No changes for Audirvāna Origin at this time.

All Origin license holders can use the Allegro design in the Remote application to control their software. Origin will be updated later this year with the new design. The signal processing suite will be available as an option.
